HELP FROM DREAMS

reams are essential to Soul's spiritual unfoldment. There are many types of dreams but the three that I work with to give me spiritual guidance are dreams of understanding, waking dreams, and golden-tongued wisdom. Dreams of understanding are what most people experience. They can foretell the future, or aid in traveling the inner worlds, give insight into health or past lives.

Waking dreams are unusual coincidences or symbols that crop up in your daily life for a spiritual purpose. Golden-tongued wisdom is defined as guidance or insight from the ECK (Holy Spirit), via a nudge, an intuitive connection to spoken or written words, or even a direct message from the Inner Master. Frequently these two blend to help Soul find answers to questions, have understanding situations in your daily life or how to live life gracefully.

I'd like to share an experience I recently had as an example of how waking dreams and golden-tongued wisdom blended for me for my benefit.

Lately I have become more focused on how

to create only good karma and to become aware when I was creating negative karma. The saying, "Is it true, is it necessary, and is it kind," kept popping up on my inner screen.

I have asked the MAHANTA, the inner side of Sri Harold Klemp, the Living ECK Master for assistance. Then it happened! I was sending an email to a client who was stressed about a situation. I decided to send her an email explaining the situation in hopes of easing tension on both sides. I finished the email and then hit send. The email went to the Outbox on my laptop and stayed there. The system was buffering, and buffering but it would not send the email. Five minutes later and it was still in the Outbox. I then said, okay, the computer must be having a problem. So, I'll just copy the email and paste it to a new email. I did and then hit send on the second email. You guessed it, even the second email stayed in the Outbox.

I then asked the MAHANTA, please help me understand what you are trying to tell me? Then I inwardly heard, "Read the email." After reading it, one sentence lit up. Yes, it certainly could have offended my client. I copied the email message, deleted the sentence and then hit send and the email went out immediately. The first 2 emails were still in the Outbox, which I then deleted.

This was certainly a waking dream, an unusual coincidence in my daily life, and the inner message, of "read the email" was an example golden-tongued wisdom.

Here was my lesson, my gift from the ECK, Holy Spirit:
